



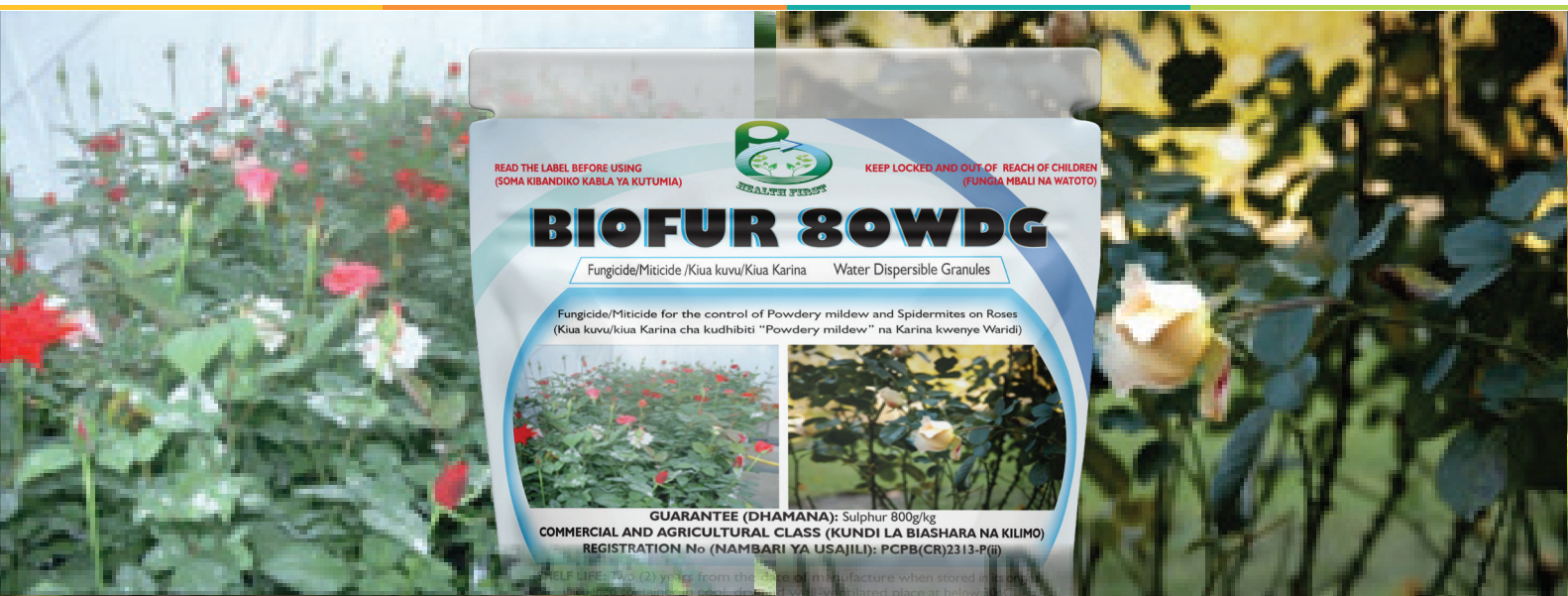

Description: BIOFUR 80 WDG (Sulphur 800g/kg) is a Fungicide/Miticide for the control of powdery Mildew and Spidermites on Roses.

Mixing instructions: Half fill the spray tank with water. Add the required amount of **BIOFUR 80 WDG** then fill the water to the required level and mix or agitate thoroughly to uniformity. Spray immediately after mixing.
