Description: ACRAMITE 5EC is an Insecticide for the control of Persea mites on Avocado

Mixing instructions: Half fill the spray tank with water. Add the required amount of **ACRAMITE 5 EC** then fill the water to the required level and mix or agitate thoroughly to uniformity. Spray immediately after mixing.



ADVANTAGES OF ACRAMITE 5 EC

- 1. Highly effective against mites.** Targets both mobile stages (larvae, nymphs, adults) of many mite species.
- 2. Fast knockdown.** Works quickly by disrupting mite energy production.
